

Don't drive your golf cart on Nephi roads illegally.

It's illegal in Utah to drive a golf cart on any city street not specifically authorized for golf cart use. Nephi City has authorized golf cart use only on the following roads:

- 700 North (including golf course road)
- 200 West from 700 North to 500 South
- 500 South from 400 East to the West city limits
- 400 East from 700 North to 500 South
- 100 South from 400 East to 800 East
- 800 East from 700 North to 100 South
- Or by taking the shortest route possible using the above streets

For your safety and the safety of others, please note the following laws:

1. Golf cart drivers must have a valid driver license.
2. Ages 14 and up may drive a golf cart only if they have a Safety Certificate.
3. No one under age 14 is allowed to drive a golf cart on Nephi City roads.
4. All occupants shall sit in an originally manufactured seat location – one person per seat.
5. Golf carts must be operated during daylight hours only, unless using factory-installed OEM headlights and taillights at non-daylight times.
6. All operators and passengers under the age of 16 must wear a DOT-certified helmet.
7. Anyone, including a minor, is subject to criminal prosecution for violating golf cart laws. Violators of this law may be charged with a Class C Misdemeanor and fined up to \$750.
8. Individuals operating any motor vehicle on city streets must adhere to all traffic laws, including speed limits and stop signs.
9. Owners of golf carts are financially responsible for damages as a result of crashes.
